## Horse riding in the Grampians National Park

Roads and tracks where horse riding is permitted are shown overleaf.

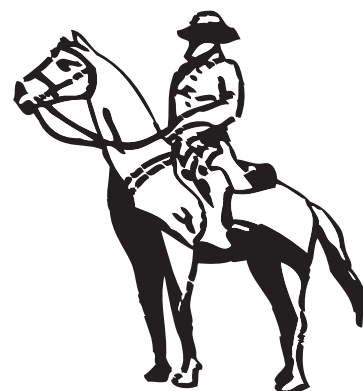
No approval is required to ride along these tracks.

There are also many opportunities to ride in adjoining State Forest.

- Keep to the road or the verge 10 metres either side.
- Overnight camping of horses is not permitted without approval.
- Beware of vehicles when riding.
- Do not ride on sealed roads, closed roads or along walking tracks.
- Please take all rubbish home

### Group Rides and Events

For a group of more than 10 horses, or events proposed by clubs or organisations, approval must be sought from the Parks Victoria - Ranger in Charge. Commercial horse riding events (where a fee is paid for instruction, leadership or use of facilities or services) require a permit.



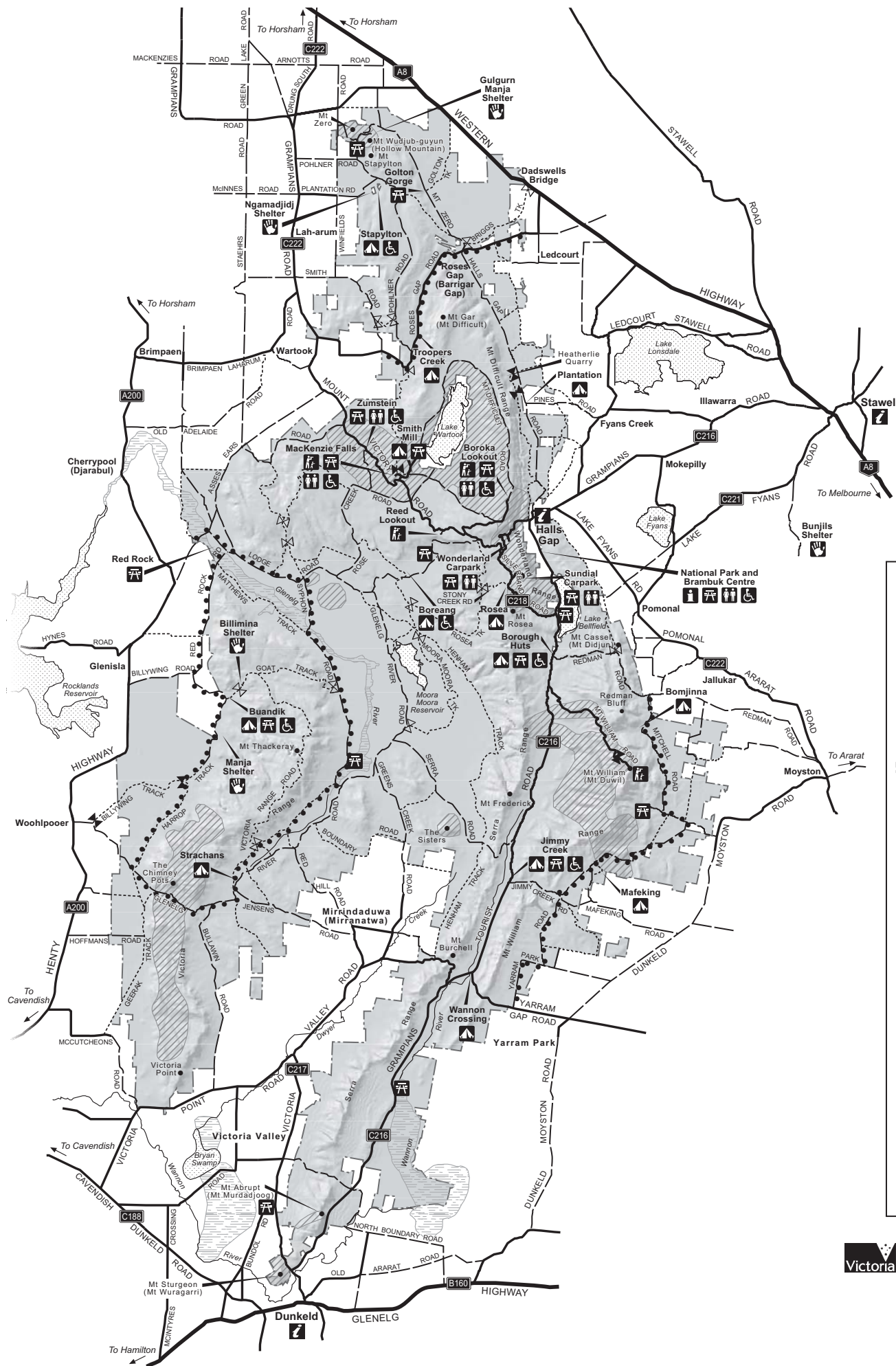
### Seeking Approval

Approval is required for groups of more than 10 horses, organised events, overnight camps or rides on tracks other than those designated on the map. Applicants should write to the Parks Victoria - Ranger in Charge, PO Box 18, Halls Gap, 3381, listing proposed route, camp locations, group size and event dates.
