Group Activities (for 12 or more people)

1) **Gariwerd Dreaming Theatre**

Creation Story: Watch & learn the Aboriginal dreamtime creation story of Gariwerd in this award winning presentation.

Cultural Landscape: This presentation gives viewers an excellent insight into many aspects of the Grampians National Park.

Cost: **\$3** per person. (Allow **35** minutes)

2) **Welcome to Country**

Learn more about the traditional people of Gariwerd, the Djab Wurrung and Jardwidjarli through a guided tour of the award winning Brambuk Aboriginal Cultural Centre. Our presenters will also explain the significance of the building and its communities.

This activity includes viewing of both films in the Gariwerd Dreaming Theatre.

Cost: **\$6** per person (Allow **50** minutes)

3) **Didgeridoo Workshop & Cultural talk**

Listen to one of our cultural officers explain the uses and techniques of traditional tools and weapons. Learn how music is an important part of Aboriginal culture, and all about the didgeridoo and its hypnotic tones.

Cost: **\$6** per person (Allow **40** minutes)

4) **Boomerang Throwing**

Learn about this unique implement and try your own hand at throwing and catching a boomerang with guidance from a cultural officer. Limited to 20 people at a time - *Weather permitting*

Cost: **\$6** per person (Allow **40** minutes)

5) **Bush Tucker Tasting**

A small tasting of Bushtucker at our Café with a brief explanation on the foods. Samples include Damper, Kangaroo, Emu and other native foods depending on availability.

Cost: **\$6** per person (Allow **25** minutes)

6) **Badeema Djilga Creations**

Create a unique memento of your Grampians/ Gariwerd trip using nature and Aboriginal art as your inspiration. (Allow **40** minutes)

7) **Bush Discovery Walk**

Join a guided walk around the native gardens and wetlands to discover the diversity of plants of Gariwerd and learn their traditional indigenous uses. This activity includes a bush tucker tasting at the Bushtucker Cafe.

8) **Bunjil's Art Site Tour**

Join us on a guided tour to view the rock art at the resting place of the Aboriginal Dreamtime creator spirit Bunjil and learn about the spiritual significance of the area. This tour also includes entry to the Gariwerd Dreaming Theatre.
