

## **Educational Activities 2015-2016**

### **1. Welcome to Country**

Learn more about the traditional people of Gariwerd, the Djab Wurrung and Jardwadjarli through a guided tour of the award winning Brambuk Aboriginal Cultural Centre. Our presenters will also explain the significance of the building and its communities.

This activity includes viewing of two films in the Gariwerd Dreaming Theatre:

**Creation Story:** Watch & learn the Aboriginal dreamtime creation story of Gariwerd in this award winning presentation.

**Cultural Landscape:** This presentation gives viewers an excellent insight into many aspects of the Grampians National Park.

### **2. Didgeridoo Workshop & Cultural talk**

Listen to one of our cultural officers explain the uses and techniques of traditional tools and weapons. Learn how music is an important part of Aboriginal culture, and all about the didgeridoo and its hypnotic tones.

### **3. Boomerang Throwing**

Learn about this unique implement and try your own hand at throwing and catching a boomerang with guidance from a cultural officer. Limited to 20 people at a time - *Weather permitting*

### **4. Bush Tucker Tasting**

A small tasting of Bushtucker at our Café with a brief explanation on the foods. Samples include Damper, Kangaroo, Emu and other native foods depending on availability.

**Cost: \$6.00 per person (Allow 20 minutes)**
